## **Summary of Responsibilities:**

- Don't hesitate to discuss any questions or concerns with the Parrot University staff person or other RBC team member, if available. It is crucial that no bird ever goes without food or water.
- Arrive at time previously scheduled with Parrot University Employee on Duty
- Follow all RBC provided checklists. These checklists may include:
  - Schedule for running the dishwasher (used to wash water bottles and food/water dishes)
  - o Schedule and procedure for replacing bird water bottles and bowls
  - Schedule and procedure for providing the birds with mash
  - Schedule and procedure for providing the birds with pellets or seeds
  - Clean up procedures (loading the washing machine with dirty towels, etc.)
- Monitor birds for signs of illness and report to the staff person.
- Assist the staff person as requested.
- If on RBC team, keep other RBC team member informed of your schedule and provide coverage if that person is off.
- Record your hours.
